### Abstract

The objective of our presentation is to provide a brief portrait of urban studies in Quebec over the past decade, particularly with regard to certain trends that seem to mark the field internationally. Based on the analysis of more than 2,000 publications in urban studies, we will identify the four main themes that dominate the field and their evolution in relation to the last review conducted more than ten years ago. Our analysis will allow us to grasp some of the issues, strengths and limitations of urban studies in Quebec in comparison with the trends that currently characterize the field.
